



First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion

First Communion Registration open until October 30th, 2025

Families who would like to have their child(ren) who are seven years of age

(grade 2) or older prepare for the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist are asked to contact the parish office or go to our website https://www.stpat-stmary-railton-odessa.com and download the First Communion letter and Registration Form.

Preparation for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist at St. Patrick Parish, Railton, involves the children's participation in lessons that will take place in the Parish Hall and by extension at home. This way parents are directly involved.

A Knight's Saint's Corner.

Saint Wolfgang, Bishop, Missionary and my Patron Saint. His Feast Day is on October 31st and also my Name's Day,

still celebrated in some countries in the same spirit as our Birthdays. Well known for more than a millennium and venerated in many regions in central Europe because of his example of Christian virtues, reforms in education and the clergy, and practicing a simple way of living. He had great concern for the poor and partly because of that many towns, villages and a lake are named after him.

Born in Swabia, Germany [c.924], he studied with the Benedictines in Reichenau and Wurzburg and by 964 entered the Monastery in Einsiedeln in Switzerland, a few years later was ordained and by 972 became Bishop of Regensburg. Just before that he and fellow monks were send east to what is now Hungary to preach the Gospel to the Magyars which was according to history short lived and disappointing. But as Bishop he was more successful but also controversial because of his innovations within the educational system, monastic life and the clergy. As a Benedictine monk he adhered to the Orders rules despite his elevation to Bishop and became known as the "Great Almoner". He also had to deal with the huge size of his diocese and on one of his travels to Austria in October 994 he fell ill and died not far from the town of Saint Wolfgang in Upper Austria. Friends brought him back to Regensburg where he is buried in the chapel of Saint Emmeram Abbey. Only a half century later he was canonized by Pope Leo IX.

Till today pilgrimages are offered between the sites of Saint Wolfgang's activities, and of course many legends and stories are kept alive which not only enhance the memory but also remind us of a saintly man and a true follower of Christ Jesus. Amen.
