## FIRST COMMUNION PROGRAM



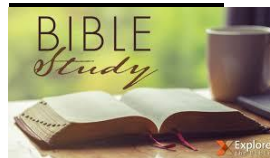
The next session for the children enrolled in the First Communion Program will be on **Tuesday, April 21<sup>st</sup> at 6:30 p.m.** in the parish hall.
