

Still acknowledged as a Servant of God but considered by the Church for canonization, Catherine de Hueck Doherty and her journey with Christ is alive and welcoming not far from us at the Madonna House Apostolate in Combermere, Ontario. Fleeing from the turmoil in Russia with her husband and son found a new home in Toronto in 1920. Poor but rich in faith and Eastern Spirituality, building up a new life which was never easy; despite all odds, by the 1930th, with the support of Toronto Bishop Neil McNeil, she founded "the Friendship House" in the city. It was her way to put the Social Teaching of the Church into practice, by being poor and helping those who needed help the most. Unfortunately, misunderstanding Communism vs. Charity in the political climate the Friendship House had to close but not without Catherine defending the Church and the Christian Virtue of Charity.

She left for New York and in Harem started a new Friendship House and was confronted with the racial issues there: she noticed the bias in the catholic communities when it came to be a Brother and Sister to the Black neighbours. Her zeal in Christian Charity, her understanding of Christ being a Brother to everyone, and after an Annulment and a second marriage to Eddie Doherty caused her and her second husband to find a new place again. They moved back to Canada in 1947 and chose to settle in Combermere and establish the "Madonna House Apostolate" under the encouragement of the Pembrook Bishop. It became a retreat and meeting place for young people and later on for clergy and more till today; with Cardinal Montini's blessing [later Pope Paul VI] Catherine and Eddi made a vow of poverty, chastity and obedience. At the time of her death in 1985 there were 16 Mission Houses in 6 countries.

One of her guiding lights were "True Silence is a key to the immense and flaming Heart of God". Sources: US. Catholic Publishing. Madonna House Apostolate.
