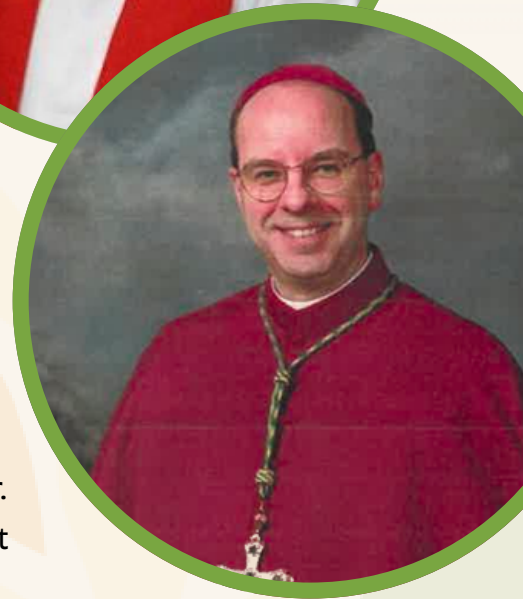
Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

- Demolition, current cost estimate of \$80K

Phase III

- Construction, cost estimate \$800K - 1.2M
- To be tendered in coming months
- Start date TBD

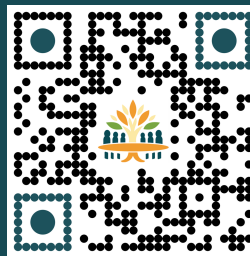

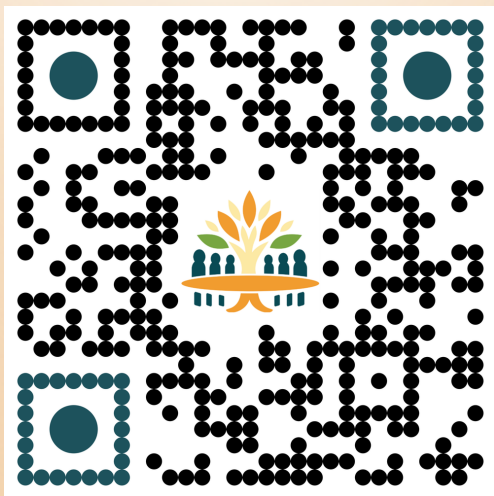
