CONFIRMATION



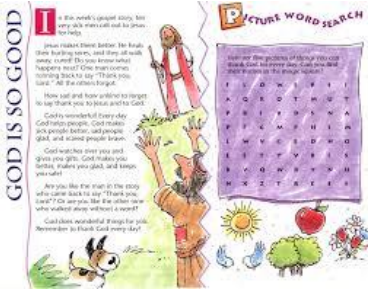
