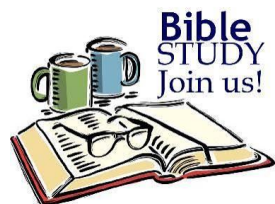

The next date for the Knights of Columbus bingo is **Monday, July 6th** starting at 7 p.m. in the parish hall. All are welcome. Bring a friend.



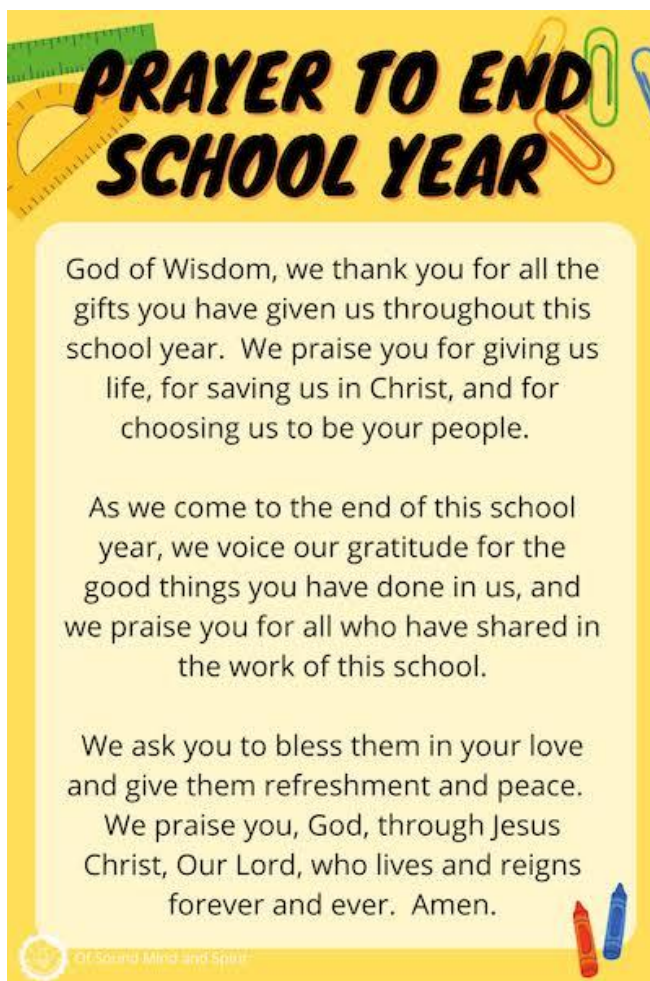
KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS HOT DOG SUNDAY

Our Rosary Group meets every **Wednesday** morning at 10 a.m. in the parish hall. All are welcome.

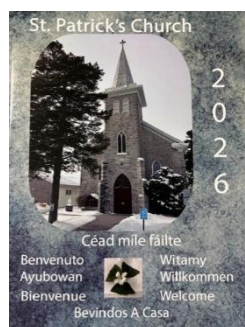


CHANGE FOR LIFE - Birthright Fundraiser
