KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS HOT DOG SUNDAY



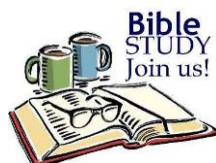
The next Knights of Columbus Hot Dog Sunday will be held after Mass on **July 19th – this weekend.**

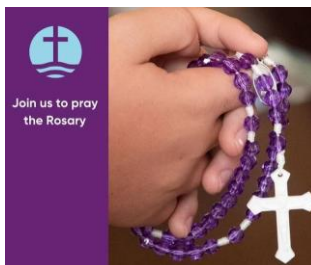
