## Nurturing Hope within Families

## Daily Activity for the Parish:

#### "Love in Marriage" Reflection Evening

Invite parishioners to join in an evening of reflection on Chapter Four of *Amoris Laetitia*, "Love in Marriage." Take the time to discuss how Pope Francis explains what it means to live out the love that Saint Paul describes. Help families see that their love reflects the love of God for every person and that this deep love of the Father should bring hope to all of us, especially our families.

### Daily Activity for Families:

"Gifts of Gratitude": Family Sharing In the busyness of life, we can sometimes forget to spend time as a family sharing the gifts God has given each member. Set time aside today to tell other family members the God-given gifts you see in them and how their gifts make your family better. Place the names of each family member in a basket. Select a name from the basket, announce the name, and ask each family member to identify one gift they see in that person. Continue to do this until all members have had a chance to see and hear how God is using each member to draw the whole family closer to Christ and to live out the Gospel more clearly in today's world.

## Cultivating Hope in those Suffering in Body, Mind, or Spirit

## **Daily Prayer Prayer Intention:** For those experiencing spiritual or physical difficulties

#### Loving Jesus,

we pray for all of those who are suffering in body, mind, or spirit.

Help them to feel your closeness in these difficult times and ease their burdens. Help them to entrust all of their worries and burdens to your loving care.

### Daily Activity for Families:

#### Prepare a meal for those in need or distress

In times of extreme difficulty, even caring for our own basic needs can feel overwhelming. As a family, find someone in your community who would find great comfort in having a meal prepared for them. Make sure to check for any food allergies or specific dietary restrictions before preparing the meal; you may want to inquire first about their favourite desserts or meals. As best as possible, try not to overburden them with the meal delivery: use containers that do not need to be returned; include any instructions needed for heating/serving; and do not overstay your welcome when dropping off the food. Include a handwritten note or card from you and your family assuring them of your prayers.

### Daily Activity for the Parish:

#### "Welcoming Hearts" Outreach Initiative

If your parish has ushers or a hospitality team, encourage them to take note of who often attends Mass by themselves. Try to greet and connect with those parishioners, taking the time to discern their specific needs and finding opportunities to provide them with assistance.

#### **Daily Prayer Prayer Intention:** For people grieving the loss of a loved one

### Daily Activity for Families:

**Planting Seeds of Remembrance and Growth** Engage your family in a meaningful activity by planting flower seeds in a pot and nurturing them together over the next few weeks. Draw a parallel between the seemingly lifeless seed that transforms into a beautiful flower and the concept that, though a loved one's body rests in the sleep of peace, we trust that our loved one will, like Jesus, rise again. Use this gardening experience as an opportunity to discuss the cycle of life, growth, and the enduring nature of love.

### Daily Activity for the Parish:

#### **Mass of Remembrance**

Organize a Mass of Remembrance for parishioners who have died during the year. Extend invitations to their families, offering them solace and support in their time of grief. The Mass of Remembrance provides an opportunity for the community to join in prayer, offering comfort and strength to those mourning the loss of their loved ones.

The homily may focus on the Holy Spirit as a source of unity and hope in families. After Mass, share a meal, fostering community and strengthening unity.

Emphasize the Holy Spirit's role in promoting hope and peace within the parish and encourage families to carry this spirit into their homes and daily lives.
