Dear Parishioners:

The Lord has risen, Alleluia!

During Holy Week and into the Easter season we celebrated our faith in Christ and are united with him not just here on earth but also when that time comes for us to enter eternal life, where we will dwell with him without any restraint of time!

During Lent, I have been reflecting over these almost 38 years of Priesthood of how my life has grown in a new way every time I celebrate the Easter mysteries. At first it seems that everything is repetitive. However, each yearly celebration of Holy Week, the Easter Triduum and the Easter Season brings a new perspective of my relationship with Christ and my ministry in the parishes that I served. For me this recalls what St. Paul wrote about himself in his first letter to the Corinthians, "when I was a child, I use to talk as a child, think as a child, reason as a child; when I became a man, I put aside childish things" (13.11). There is a development of building upon what we know by solidly growing with Jesus. Nothing is ever static! We can stumble along the way, yet it does not mean that we stay down. Christ pulls us up and encourages us to continue moving to the destiny that he has prepared for us. I hope that your Lenten devotions and your reflection on your life with God has indeed been uplifting for you so that your practice of faith in Christ is always being renewed no matter what.
