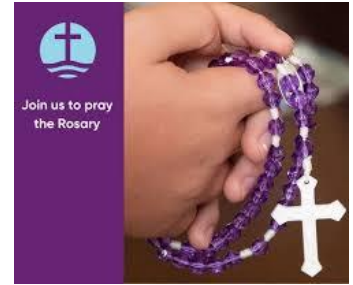

Angèle Regnier is co-founder, with her husband André, of Catholic Christian Outreach (CCO). A natural teacher, Angèle pioneered CCO's programs for evangelization and discipleship, as well as the faith study series used by CCO for over 37 years. In 2015, André and Angèle received the Pro Ecclesiae Pontifical medal, the highest award that can be given to the laity by the pope, from Pope Francis. In 2018, she spearheaded and was the media spokesperson for a national pilgrimage of the relic forearm of St. Francis Xavier. Together with their eight children, they spoke at Pope Paul VI Hall in Vatican City sharing on the universal baptismal call to mission in 2019.

August 21st, 1879

On a wet dark August evening in 1879, the villagers of Knock, County Mayo, Ireland had spent the day doing the usual work of the harvest time of the year. As evening approached, the villagers gathered around the turf fire in their homes, taking comfort and shelter on a fumble night. Suddenly word spread throughout the village that something extraordinary was happening at the Church and so they turned to the windswept gable where they witnessed a heavenly vision surrounded in a brilliant white light.

The Vision

The witnesses clearly saw the Blessed Virgin Mary dressed in white robes, her hands and eyes turned towards heaven in prayer. On her head was a gold crown and where the crown fitted the brow, a single golden rose. On her right, bowed respectfully towards her, was St. Joseph. To Our Lady's left stood John the Evangelist veiled as a bishop, wearing a small mitre. He stood so that his back was neither turned to the Virgin or to the Lamb that stood upon a simple plain altar. Behind the Lamb was a Cross. The witnesses watched and prayed for over two hours and though they were wet, they noticed that no rain fell upon the apparition or on the gable.

August 10th, 2025

This year's Pilgrimage to honour Our Lady of Knock will be held on Sunday, August 10th, 2025. The Eucharist will be celebrated in English by Archbishop Paul-André Durocher assisted by Father Greg Murray of St. Malachy's parish.
