6:00 a.m. departure (Departing from St. Mary's Cathedral, pick up stops in Kingston, Napanee and Belleville)

In preparation for the 2025 Jubilee Year (Pilgrims of Hope), St. Mary's Cathedral is planning a parish pilgrimage to the Canadian Martyr's Shrine in Midland, Ontario. This historic and holy site includes the famous Shrine Church situated on 75 beautifully landscaped acres. Within the Church are relics of the Martyrs St. Jean de Brebeuf, St. Gabriel Lamont and St. Charles Garnier.

Father Shawn will celebrate Mass at St. Ignace, the site of the martyrdom of the Jesuits. Also included are a guided tour of the Shrine, outdoor Stations of the Cross, a visit to Sainte Marie Among the Hurons, plus an opportunity to take time to enter into prayer in a tranquil setting or visit the Shrine Museum and archives before departing for home.
