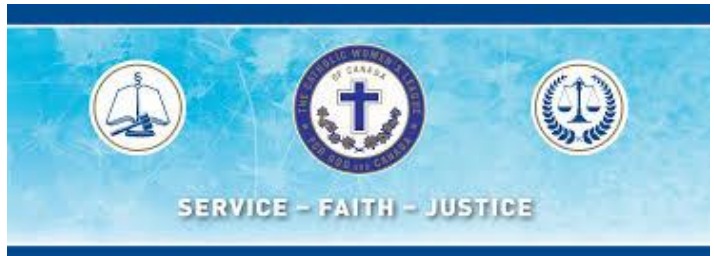

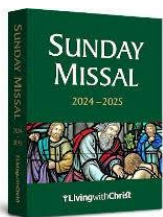

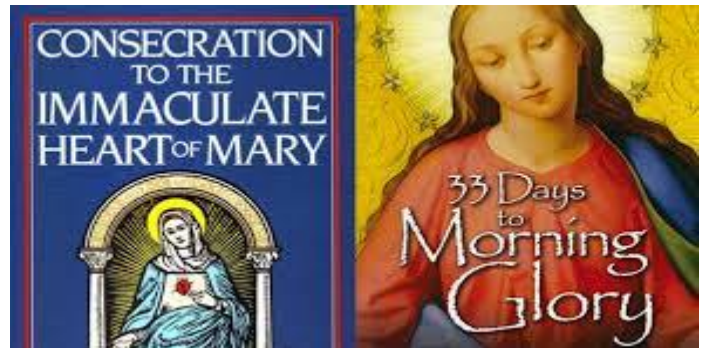
### **The Franciscans: Is God Calling You?**
