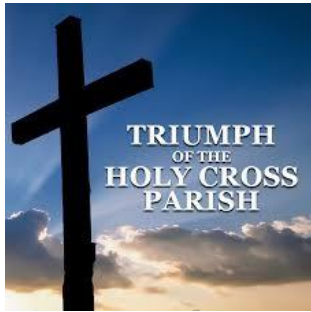

KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS HAMBURGER LUNCH

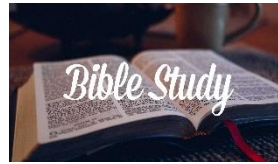
This weekend - after Mass on **Sunday, September 21st** the Knights of Columbus will host a

ST. PATRICK'S CEMETERY MASS

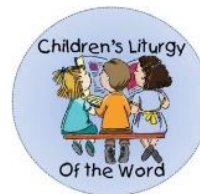

Parents Meeting for First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion

Families who would like to have their child(ren) who are seven years of age (grade 2) or older prepare for the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist are asked to contact the parish office or go to our website <https://www.stpat-stmary-railton-odessa.com> and download the **First Communion letter and Registration Form.**

Preparation for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist at St. Patrick Parish, Railton, involves the children's participation in lessons that will take place in the Parish Hall and by extension at home. This way parents are directly involved. **There will be a mandatory parent meeting on Sunday, 5 October 2025 at 12:15 p.m. (following the 11am Mass) in the church. If you are not able to be there on that day the same meeting content will take place Tuesday, 7 October at 7:00pm in the parish hall.** The meeting will consist of an outline of the program as well as encouraging you to be supportive of your child and to try your best to be interested in what your child is doing. Parents who want to register their child for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist can go to the parish website (see above) and download the Registration Form.

You are asked to fill out the required information and include a copy your child's **Catholic Baptismal Certificate.** **Please bring them to the Parent meeting.** **Do not return the registration form to school.**
